Pronunciation is as in English except for the following. a e i o u are pronounced as in “Pa let me go to.” Each vowel and letter have only one clear sound Pronunciation is as follows:

c like the ts sound of ts,

ch like the ch in chew,

g like the g in go,

gh like the g in gem,

j like the y in yes,

jh like the s in pleasure,

s like the s in set,

sh like the sh in ship,

uh like the w in now,

hh like the ch in loch. Is rare. There is no q w x

y. The accent is on the next to last syllable.  
No exceptions in the grammar.

All words are pronounced as spelled and spelled as pronounced.
